Worship Service Assistants

Communion Server: Help serve communion to worshippers – approximately four times a year.

Altar Guild: Prepare elements for communion services. Help out twice a month for one month per year. Total time commitment is approximately 1.5 to 2 hours per month (about 1.5 hours on the first weekend of the month and about ten minutes on the other weekend.)

Powerpoint Runner: Advance Power Point for weekly church services. Serve approximately six a year.

Infant and Toddler Nursery Caregiver: Work in nursery Sundays caring for children ages birth to 4. Both parents and those who do not have children this age are welcome. Time commitment is approximately two hours once every two months. **Special Events Caregiver:** Help provide childcare at various church meetings such as baptism or new member classes, church-wide meetings, or other events. Special events occur approximately once a month.

Vacation Bible School: Our week-long VBS is held annually. Music, skits, crafts, snacks and Bible lessons are offered to the children as they rotate between stations. Many volunteers, adults and teens, are needed to host this exciting week.
