Who is this retreat for?

It's for all adult women (18 and older). Whether you are new to Holy Trinity or have been here for years, this retreat is for you.

What is the facility like?

This is a newer camp that opened in 2006. The cabins have 14 beds, heated floors, and a loft area that is carpeted. Each cabin has 2 showers, bathrooms and 7 bunk-beds.

What should I expect?

Solid Biblical teaching, worship, ice-breaker games, small group discussion, skits, food and gracious, friendly women in a relaxed atmosphere.

From New Prague

Follow Highway 19 east out of New Prague. Turn left onto County Rd 86 to continue eastward, crossover I-35 and continue to Highway 52 just north of Cannon Falls. Take Hwy. 52 south until the Hwy. 60 exit, just past Zumbrota. Take Hwy. 60 east, 5 miles to Mazeppa. One mile past Mazeppa turn right (south) onto Hwy. 7. Follow the road over a large, green bridge and start up a long hill. About 1/4 mile past the green bridge you will see Camp Victory, off the right side of the road (about 65 miles)
