Why did you offer to volunteer? "I thought it was perfect for me because I enjoy playing soccer. It didn't feel like a job to me."

How did you make it work with COVID-19 precautions in place? "Initially, due to COVID, we were unable to meet so I made <u>videos of me</u> teaching a soccer drill that Pastor Jorge would send to the youth families. For the first month, this is what I did. Then in July, we started Monday and Tuesday each week".

What was the highlight of the experience? "For me, the highlight was to just play soccer with the kids. I enjoy working with young players."

How did the soccer coaching go? "It was a good experience. We had about 4 boys and 8 girls, ages 3rd-5th grade. All the kids listened and wanted to be there to have fun. Going back each week was an easy decision because I was having fun, and I gave them my word that I would come each week."
