I grew up fumbling through shopping ads with my brother and cousins after our big Thanksgiving dinner meal at our grandparents home, as we prepared our strategy and route for the early Black Friday shopping. Then, in our early years of our marriage, there were years Alicia and I celebrated Thanksgiving by scrambling from one family gathering to the next on the same day. One year, while we lived in an apartment complex, we decided to have all our family -Alicia's and mine - to our place for Thanksgiving. We even used a friend's apartment down the hall for an extra oven. Lots of people. Lots of food. Lots of fun memories.
