Do you have someone in your life that's waiting to be baptized? Have you been holding off because of COVID-19? Are you wondering if we're doing baptisms right now at all?

Holy Trinity is hosting a special baptism service on Saturday, April 3. There's a long-standing tradition in the Christian church of having Holy Saturday (the night before Easter) as a special baptism service. Some churches only perform baptisms on this Holy day, as the baptized join in the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

This service will be in Holy Trinity's parking lot (weather dependent) at dusk. We'll have multiple baptism fonts at different parts of the parking lot

for each family unit. In the middle, we'll have a fire (an Easter Vigil tradition). We'll share a couple stories about how God brings life out of death in the Bible. We'll hold onto the resurrection of Jesus as our hope that we too join in the promise of eternal life through the waters of baptism.

MARCH MISSION DRIVE


To help our ministry partner, Christo Obrero, to have a fun Easter season, we are collecting:
