Treasurer's report

Reviewed end of year combining balance sheet. 25 drive match funds added to STD fund. Jesse reviewed the Balance Sheet funds we monitor each month for new members to review.

We are waiting for the PPP loan forgiveness notice, expected soon.

Operating statement review - revenue and expenses down as was trending through 2020. About \$70000 below budget for revenues but most offset by lower expenses. We did not use 25 Drive dollars to offset any losses - the full amount is available for the budget.this year.

• Mission Outreach Team provides Support for MPLS Area Synod, as part of their budgeted giving. Amounts are determined each year by council

Motion by Hemann - continue the Synod Mission Outreach donation as a 6% increase over last years giving amount which would be \$ 23500, second by Schoenecker- motion passed

Pastor Ben Report

- Reviewed his report highlighting a donation toward a new sign, and plan to seek background information for any project will be led by Mark Walser.
- Online worship plan to expand to television with an opportunity to share a rotational spot with other churches on FOX 9+ on Sundays.
- Lenten devotional preparation and plans for Lent are continuing

New Business

- COVID update Pastor Alicia shared regarding the Risk management team -FAITH and FACTS is how we approach our decisions each month. Meeting with the MDH and other leaders to learn the current updates. Recommend staying the course with online/radio/tv/worship (phase 2) allowing time for vaccines to be administered waiting for a hybrid experience to develop over time as the new space in the building is completed and live stream technology is ready for use.
- Luther Seminary Cohort- Congregations in a Secular Age Program that Luther Seminary is offering and invited our church to participate. The program focus is faith formation through experimentation, research and reflection. Individual, small group and congregational participation is included. It's a multi year commitment with an investment of approximately \$2000 in cost for participation.

- Construction ceiling in fellowship hall is completed. A tour of the addition happened recently online. Final touches expected over the next weeks. Staff will stagger moving into the space as able. Bathrooms are making progress and expected to be done this first quarter of the year.
