Position Title: Media Specialist

Classification/FLSA: Non-Exempt

Reports to: Pastor

Summary/Objective of Position: Holy Trinity is looking for a Media Specialist to provide on-site media support to in-person worship services.

Essential Functions:

- Mixes sound during Sunday morning and Wednesday evening worship services, as well as Christmas, Easter and other special worship events.
- Mixes sound during rehearsals, performing sound checks to troubleshoot issues prior to worship.
- Operates video and lighting equipment for services, rehearsals, and special events as needed.
- Trains volunteers in operating sound and video equipment as needed.
- Complies with licensing and copyright standards.

Competencies:

- Initiative enjoys working hard and is action-oriented and energetic; does not wait for direct requests to complete obvious tasks; looks to improve processes and procedures.
- Leadership skilled at building and directing a team of volunteers.
- Knowledge proficient in sound system logistics and live streaming procedures.
- Attention to Detail attends to issues and circumstances which must be addressed; takes pride in consistently producing excellent audio and visual experiences.
- Team Orientation demonstrates interest, skill and success in team environments; communicates with integrity with all staff; steps up to offer self as a resource to other members of the team; professional in appearance and demeanor so as not to detract from organization success.
