We seek to provide a customized curriculum that includes learning about the Bible, church history, Lutheran theology, and also discuss issues particularly relevant for students today. After a few years of an adapted confirmation experience, it feels so good to look forward to something normal. I'm excited for a great year!

Confirmation Layout

- •5:00pm Dinner: This is optional, but a wonderful chance to have a home cooked meal in the middle of a busy week!
- •6:00pm Worship: Worship is central to a life of faith, and central to the Holy Trinity Confirmation Experience.
- •6:50pm Large Group Lesson: After worship, students will stay in the sanctuary for a large group lesson, pertaining to the topic of the week.
- •7:10-7:30pm Small Groups: Students and leaders will then break off into their small group rooms for discussion and reflection.

Key Components

- Weekly Participation: Students will be expected to participate weekly in worship, large group lessons, and small groups discussions.
- Sermon Notes: During worship, students will take sermon notes on the backs of the bulletins, which they will hand into their small group leaders.
- <u>Service Teams</u>: Students will jump into one of four service teams:
 - Worship Support Team (1x/month): this team will be in charge of helping with worship (ushering, A/V, reading, etc.)
 - Kitchen Team (1x/month): this team will help the kitchen team serve and clean up the Wednesday dinner meal.
 - •Bell Choir (1x/month): students can volunteer to play in the Bell Choir! They will practice at 5pm the same day they play at 6pm.
 - Little Free Food Pantry (Rotational Schedule): students will be asked to fill the little free food pantries with items for those in need.
