Composting Proposal (Carson Sayler)

 Carson is proposing the HTLC kitchen staff start using a compost bin for compostable items. Carson will take the bin weekly to the compost site by the high school. Council agreed this is a great idea, and proposed Carson meet with the kitchen team to review.

NEXT Project Introduction

- Finance Team Financing Recommendations (Gieseke)
 - Only spend what is actually generated by the campaign; any long-term financing would require a second campaign, which is not ideal
 - We anticipate using Mission Investment Fund for a line of credit/construction loan. This is the only financing we would utilize, which we would pay off over three years as the pledged amounts come in
- Capital Campaign Leadership (Laura Magnuson, Pat Remfert, Lindsey and Adam Cornell)
 - Lead Gifts Phase 14 gatherings with 92 families held over 2 months. Much enthusiasm and support for the project! 46 pledges to date.
- Team Recommendation
 - Goal of \$2.5M budget with a stretch goal of \$3M
 - Station 19 has been working on a base plan recommendation as well as add ons;
 Plan will be presented soon, which will then be relayed to Langer Construction to price out the base plan, as well as the add ons.
- Facilitated Discussion
 - Council discussed the budget but will review Station 19's initial plan before making a decision
