What You Need

- <u>Bible</u>: Each confirmation student is given an adult study Bible as they begin confirmation. Please bring your Bible every week.
- •Binder: Please bring your own 3 ring binder (1/2 inch or 1 inch thick).

Schedule Each Week

- 5:00 pm Dinner: This is optional, but a wonderful chance to have a home cooked meal in the middle of a busy week!
- <u>6:00 pm Worship</u>: Worship is central to a life of faith, and central to the Holy Trinity Confirmation Experience.
- 6:50 pm Large Group Lesson: After worship, students receive a large group lesson in the Fellowship Hall, pertaining to the topic of the week.
- <u>7:10-7:30 pm Small Groups</u>: Students participate in mixed gender groups, with two different adult leaders per group. Each week, these small groups meet to discuss the sermon notes, learn about their Bibles, build relationships with one another, and pray.

Key Components

- Weekly Participation: Students will be expected to participate weekly in worship, large group lessons, and small groups discussions.
- <u>Sermon Notes</u>: During worship, students will take sermon notes on the backs of the bulletins. By the end of the 2023-24 year, students will be expected to complete at least 20 sermon notes.
- Service Teams: Students will jump into one of five service teams:
 - Worship Support Team (1x/month): This team will be in charge of helping with worship (ushering, A/V, reading, etc.)
 - <u>Kitchen Team</u> (1x/month): This team will help the kitchen team serve and clean up the Wednesday dinner meal.
 - <u>Bell Choir</u> (1x/month): Students can volunteer to play in the Bell Choir! They will practice at 5pm the same day they play at 6pm.
 - <u>Little Free Pantry</u> (Rotational Schedule): Students will be asked to fill the Little Free Pantries with items for those in need.
 - Compline Support Team (1x/month): Support this reflective Sunday night worship service (sing, set up prayer stations, run A/V).
