BULLETIN COVER: James Baldwin (1924–1987) was a writer and intellectual whose essays, novels, and speeches confronted the realities of racism in America. His works, such as *The Fire Next Time* and *Notes of a Native Son*, exposed the deep wounds of racial injustice while challenging both white and Black audiences to reckon with the nation's history. Baldwin's incisive critiques of power and privilege made him a moral voice of the Civil Rights Movement, and his advocacy for Black liberation remains profoundly influential today. 
